**-:: ORDER ::-**

[1] The brief facts of the case is that deceased Vimalkumar Shivshankar Yagnik expired on 11/05/2019 and present applicants are administrators of the said deceased. Deceased had passed away without making any will or testament in respect of his immovable property. Applicants had not filed any application before any other court for obtaining Letter

of Administration mentioned of the deceased Vimalkumar Shivshankar Yagnik. And, present applicants have preferred an application to issue Letter of Administration under the provisions of **The Indian Succession Act**, in the name of the applicant in respect of the immovable property of deceased as mentioned in Schedule at Mark 1/1.

- [2] Now looking to the present application, the public notice inviting objection to the grant of Letter of Administration published in daily newspaper 'Akila' on 03/02/2026 and the copy of said newspaper is produced on record vide Ex. 12. And after that in response to the publication of the said notice, no one has appeared to file any objection. The applicants have also produced the following documentary evidence in support of their application:-

- [3] No one appeared to file any objection in response to the publication of notice in daily newspaper as discussed above. In the present case, the applicants have sought to obtain the Letter of Administration of the immovable property of the deceased in view of the **Indian Succession Act**, which provides for the Letter of Administration to declare them the administrator of the property of the deceased who died in intestacy.
- [4] Therefore, taking into consideration, all above affidavits and documents, it is clear that no objections or any dispute will be raised by any heirs when order is passed by this Court to issue Letter of Administration to the applicants. Therefore in view of above discussion, there is no reason to disbelieve the version of the applicants. Thus, applicants are rightful to get Letter of Administration in respect of immovable property of the said deceased.

Therefore after considering the application and supporting documents and affidavits it appears that applicants are rightful heirs and applicants are entitled to get the Letters of Administration of the deceased and therefore following order is passed:-

-: **ORDER** :-

- [1] The present application is hereby granted.

- [2] The Letter of Administration in respect of the immovable property of deceased Vimalkumar Shivshankar Yagnik as described in the schedule of the properties produced with this application be issued in the name of applicants Jatin Vimalbhai Yagni and Mayur Vimalbhai Yagni on payment of requisite court fees on the value of the property.
- [3] The above order is given only in respect of the acknowledgment of administrator and is not given to determine the right, title, interest or partition of any of the parties so that the above order will not be binding/affecting any proceedings for any existing law or for determination of right, title, interest or share.
