Complaint under sec.33-A of the I. D. Act.

: Award :

(1). The present complaint is preferred by the complainant / applicant under sec.33-A of the I. D. Act, seeking relief to declare the system of offering tenders and entrustment of work by opponents is illegal, unjust and improper by considering the procedure as sham. He has further prayed that the officers and servants of the opponent be restrained from terminating the employees illegally without making the payment of legal dues as well as retrenchment compensation.

(2). The present case was initially instituted before Central Government Industrial Tribunal, Ahmedabad which was then after transferred to this Tribunal by the Central Government by the order of the Ministry of Labour department, Government of India and as per the office order of the President, Industrial Court, Ahmedabad. So it was issued new number and notices were issued to the parties. The case was pending for submitting evidence from the applicant's side. In pursuance to the same the applicant has remained present, who has submitted pursis at Exh.32 stating that after preferring the present complaint he was illegally terminated from service for which he has preferred reference case which is pending before the Tribunal vide Ref. (ITC) No.117/2025, so now he does not want to proceed with this

complaint hence he has submitted the said withdraw pursis. The complainant was identified by Ld. advocate Mr. A. C. Shah as well as the applicant has even submitted copy of his adhar card. After verifying the voluntariness of the applicant said pursis was recorded. Accordingly, in terms of the said withdraw pursis, following final order is passed in the larger interest of justice.

:: ORDER ::

(1). The present complaint case stands disposed off in this Lok adalat, in terms of withdraw pursis submitted by the applicant side at Exh.32.

(2). The parties will have to bear their own respective cost of this proceedings.
