The brief facts of this petition :-

The claim petition had arisen out of the vehicular accident had occurred on dtd. 04/11/2025. That in the impugned accident, the applicant sustained injuries on various parts of the body including fracture. Therefore, the claimant has claimed compensation of Rs. 3,50,000/- on various grounds from all the opponents along with interest jointly and severally.

The compromise pursis **Exh. No. 12** has been presented in Special Sitting (General Lok-Adalat) by both the concerned parties for full and final settlement of present petition, on the basis of which, the Tribunal has passed the Order/Award in following Manner.

ORDER

- (1) Heard and perused the Compromise pursis as well as case record. Both the side have jointly tendered compromise pursis vide **Exhibit no. 12** and upon ascertaining by this court, the terms shown therein and signature put in the compromise pursis have been admitted and thereby confirmed that on the terms agreed upon and shown in the pursis, they seek to dispose of the matter. As the compromise appears to be voluntary one, the present case is hereby disposed of as compromised as per the terms agreed upon in the pursis.
- (2) Upon depositing the amount of compensation **Rs. 2,50,000/-** as agreed upon, the same shall be distributed to claimant/s as follows:-
- (3) Out of the amount of compensation, **50%** amount shall be paid to the claimant/s(s) by A/c. Payee Cheque and remaining **50%** shall be deposited in the name of claimant/s(s) in any Nationalized Bank for a period of **five (5) years.**

- (4) It is hereby directed that the claimant/s shall not be entitled to raise any loan, or advance, or withdraw the amount of F.D.R. before maturity without prior permission of this Tribunal.
- (5) The claimant/s shall be entitled to get periodical interest accrued upon the said F.D.R.
- (6) No court fee is required to be deducted from the amount of compensation agreed upon.
- (7) Court fee refund be issued to the parties concerned or their advocates as per Section 21(1) of the Legal Services Authority Act.
