

**ORDER BELOW C.R.M.A(BAIL) APPLICATION NO.233/2026
FOR OFFENCE REGISTERED NO. 11209024260181 JADAR
POLICE STATION**

1. Heard learned advocate of accused Learned APP on behalf of State. Perused the documents in hand. The present application has been filed for the bail of the accused from the offense under sections 318(4),61(2) of The Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (BNS) and 66(c),66(d) of IT Act.
2. The learned advocate for the accused has submitted that the accused is permanent local resident and there are no chances for his absconding or evading trial in this matter. Also, the accused is ready and willing to obey any condition which is to be imposed by this Court.
3. In present case the charge sheet has already been filed but the offence in question is an organized crime, having massive societal impact. Every player, participating in a scam related to Cyber Fraud, plays pivotal role, in one way or the other. Considering that the matter at hand pertained to digital fraud, these matters have to be dealt with extra sensitivity and a different approach as these offences not only erode the public trust and confidence but also impact the entire Society.
4. Therefore, looking to the gravity of offence, it seems to this Court that the accused should kept aloof from his liberty and hence I pronounce the following order:

1. The present application is hereby **Rejected**.
