ORDER

Case is called out. Accused is present. Learned counsel for accused has filed application U/sec. 241 Cr.PC and submits that accused is ready to plead guilty.

Learned counsel for the accused has produced a decision of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Criminal Case No. 87294/2016 between the State V/s Chander Pal.

Heard Learned counsel for the accused and Learned APP.

A perusal of order sheet shows that the charge for the offence punishable under section 379 of IPC has been framed against the accused on 15.03.2023. He has not pleaded guilty, but claimed to be tried. Hence, the case has been posted for evidence.

Now the accused intends to plead guilty of the alleged offence. As per the decision of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India the accused can plead guilty at any subsequent stage of trial.

Once again the charge for the offence punishable U/sec. 379 of IPC is framed and read over to the accused. He pleads guilty of the offence punishable U/sec. 379 of IPC. Plea of the accused is voluntary one. Same is accepted.

Hence, acting U/sec 241 of Cr.PC, I hereby convict the accused for the offence P/U/sec. 379 of IPC .

The accused is sentenced pay fine of Rs.3,500/- for the offence punishable U/sec. 379 IPC. In default he shall undergo S.I. for 1 month. Interim custody of the vehicle is made absolute.

Properties mentioned at serial No. 1 and 3 of column No. 11 of the charge sheet shall be disposed according to the provisions of MMDR Act.
