**Application U/s. 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha
Sanhita.**

:: O R D E R ::

1. The present application is preferred by the applicant - accused under the provision of **Section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (B.N.S.S.)**, for release of applicant - accused on bail in respect to arrest in offence registered with Chowkbazar Police Station with C.R. No. 11210012260309/2026, punishable under Sections 115(2), 296(B), 352, 351(3) of B.N.S and u/s 135 of G.P. Act. The applicant - accused is in judicial custody since 07.03.2026. Hence, the present regular bail application.

2. Perusing the FIR in question, the case of the prosecution transpires to the effect that on 21/02/2026, when the complainant and his friend were standing on a public road near River View Society Gate No. 1, Fulwadi, Barimata Road, Surat, the present applicant is alleged to have come there, pushed the complainant and he is alleged to have started arguing and abusing the complainant. Further, the applicant/accused is alleged to have assaulted him with fists and kicks and he is alleged to have threatened the complainant to kill him by showing knife. Thereby, the accused is alleged to have committed the aforesaid offence.

3. Notice of the present application has been duly served upon the respondent - State, Ld. DGP Shri N. L. Sukhadwala has appeared for respondent - State and the Investigating Officer has submitted his affidavit at **Exh. 4**.

4. Learned advocate for the applicant has submitted that applicant - accused is innocent and he has not committed any offence. The applicant - accused has been falsely implicated in the alleged offence. It is further submitted that no recovery or discovery made out from the applicant. It is also submitted that most of the investigation qua the applicant is almost over and applicant has responsibility of looking after his family. The applicant is also a local resident of Surat. Thus, on these grounds Ld. Advocate for the applicant has urged to allow the present application.

5. Per contra the Learned DGP appeared on behalf of the State has opposed the grant of relief and submitted that there is prima facie case against the applicant. There are three criminal antecedents against the applicant. He has expressed his apprehension that if the applicant is enlarged on bail, he may again indulge in such type of illegal activities or he may flee away, thus, has submitted the

present application needs to be rejected.

6. Having heard the Ld. Advocates for the respective parties and perusing the papers, it appears that the applicant - accused is in judicial custody since 07.03.2026 and it seems that major portion of the investigation qua the applicant is likely to be over. Further, considering the contents of FIR, punishment prescribed for the offence, nature of allegation and also taking into account the fact that the alleged offence is triable by JMFC, it is desirable to exercise discretionary power in favour of applicant - accused with specific condition. Accordingly, the following order is passed :

:: ORDER ::

1. The present Criminal Misc. Application No. 1844/2026 stands **allowed**.
2. The applicant **Abdul Raheman @ Sonu Mohmmad Shabbir Shah** is hereby ordered to be released on bail in connection with the offence registered vide Part A-C.R. No. 11210012260309/2026 registered before Chowkbazar Police Station, Surat, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.

15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand) and surety of the like amount subject to following **conditions** that the applicant shall :

- (a) not take undue advantage of his liberty or misuse liberty.
 - (b) not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case.
 - (c) furnish the documentary proof of complete, correct and present address of residence to the Investigating Officer and to the Trial Court at the time of executing the bond and shall not change the residence without prior permission of the concerned Court.
 - (d) provide contact numbers as well as the contact numbers of the surety before the Trial Court. In case of change in such numbers inform in writing immediately to the trial Court.
 - (e) not leave India without prior permission of the Court concerned.
 - (f) mark presence before the concerned Police Station on every 1st and 15th day of english calendar month till the filing of charge-sheet.
3. Trial Court shall be at liberty to delete, modify and/or relax any of the above conditions, in accordance with law.
 4. Bail bond be executed before the concerned Court.

5. Yadi of this order be sent to all the concerned.
