ORDER:

1. Applicant/accused Gurjeet Singh son of Buta Singh, resident of Village Chughe Khurd PS Nandgarh, District Bathinda, has filed the present application under section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail in the above F.I.R.; notice of which was given to the respondent/State and Sh.Amarjeet Syal, Addl.PP is present to represent the State.

2. As per version of the prosecution on 11.08.2020, a police party headed by SI Major Singh, apprehended the applicant-accused in the area of Chughe Khurd and 5 Kgs of poppy husk was recovered from him, which is a non-commercial quantity under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985. He is in custody since 11.08.2020. Presentation of challan and conclusion of trial will take sufficient long time. He is ready to appear before the trial court and to abide by the terms and conditions of bail, to be imposed upon him. Applicant-accused has permanent place of abode within the jurisdiction of this Court. In such circumstances, no useful purpose will be served by detaining him behind the bars for an indefinite period. .

3. **Keeping in view the above facts, nature of allegations and period of custody, the applicant/accused is entitled for regular bail in the above case. Hence, his bail application is allowed. He be released on bail, on his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/-with one surety of the like amount, to the satisfaction of this Court/Duty Judge.**
