Heard on the application for regular bail of applicant-accused
in the above noted FIR.

2- Notice of the same was given to respondent/State. Sh. T.S.
Sidhu, Ld. Addl. P P is present to represent the State.

3- As per prosecution allegations, 216 bottles of liquor meant
for sale in Haryana only were allegedly recovered from the applicant-
accused on 9.4.2019. Applicant was arrested in this case on 7.8.2019 and
now is in judicial custody. Offence under section 61 of Excise Act are
triable by the Magistrate. Presentation of challan and completion of trial
of case will take considerable time. The applicant has permanent place of
abode. There is no apprehension that applicant-accused will abscond away
or will not face the trial, if released on bail. In these circumstance, no
useful purpose would be served by keeping the applicant-accused behind
the bars for an indefinite period.

4- **Keeping in view the above facts, nature of allegations,
the period of incarnation, he is found entitled for regular bail. As
such, the application is allowed. Applicant-accused be released on
bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds in the sum of
Rs. 50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction
of the Illaqa/Duty Magistrate.**

5- Copy of this order be sent to trial Court. Bail application be
consigned to the record room.
