

BA 242 2022 Lovepreet Singh etc vs State of Punjab

Heard on the bail application moved by
applicant/accused Lovepreet Singh and Manvir Singh under section
457/380/411 of IPC, PS Lambi.

Counsel for the accused/applicant Lovepreet Singh and
Manvir Singh has argued that accused have been falsely implicated
in the given FIR as they have not committed any offence as alleged
in the FIR. On these grounds, request was made that the bail
application.

On the other side Ld. APP for the State opposed the said
application and argued that the offence committed by the accused is
serious in nature, therefore, the bail should not be granted and bail
application may kindly be dismissed.

I have heard Ld. APP for the State and Ld. Counsel for
the accused/applicant as per their plea and counter plea and gone
through the police file carefully.

Heard. The trial in the given case is yet to begin.
Accused are in custody since 15.05.2022. Recovery has already been
effected from the accused. As such, considering the averments in the
application and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the
accused in custody in given case. Therefore, accused Lovepreet
Singh and Manvir Singh are admitted on bail on furnishing the bail
bonds in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- each with one surety in the like
amount. Bail bonds and surety bonds not furnished.
