The case having been finally heard on 8<sup>th</sup> March, 2025 and the court on the same day passed the following:

**ORDER**

Accused is alleged to have committed the offences punishable under section 281 BNS and 185 of the MV Act.

2. Prosecution case is that on 17.12.2024 at .....5:00... pm, the accused drove a .... (bearing registration no. KL 29 J 6420...) in rash and negligent manner by consuming liquor through the Kumbalham road junction



3. The case is seen suo moto registered by the S.I. of police, Kayamkulam, who investigated the case as well. Upon the completion of the investigation, final report was laid against the accused alleging the aforesaid offence. Cognizance was taken. Accused appeared before court, today. Copies of the case records were served on the accused. When the particulars of the offence under sections 281 BNS and 185 of the MV Act were stated, the accused pleaded guilty. I am satisfied that the admission is voluntary and after understanding its consequences. So, it is accepted and the accused found guilty and convicted under section 275 BNSE of the offence u/s. 281 BNS and 185(a) of the MV Act.

4. Therefore, the accused is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs. 400/- & Si till rising of the court for the offence punishable u/s. 281 BNS and 185(a) of the MV Act. In default to undergo simple imprisonment for 4 days.
