ORDER:

Present order of mine shall dispose off bail application filed by applicant-Satpal Singh.

2. Brief facts of the bail application are that applicant has been falsely implicated in this case. It has been further stated that applicant is a law abiding citizen and he has not committed any offence. It has been further stated that applicant is ready to join the investigation. Hence, it is prayed that applicant be admitted to bail.

3. Upon notice, learned Addl.PP for State appeared and contested the bail application.

4. I have heard learned counsel for applicant, learned Addl.PP for State and have gone through the records of the case file carefully.

The present FIR was registered at the instance of Sukhwant Singh on the allegations that on 29.09.2021 at about 1:00 PM he was coming on his motor cycle bearing No.PB31-M-8068 black colour make Hero HF Delux and had gone to Gurudwara Dera Baba Sant Singh of his village. He further stated that he parked the motor cycle outside the Gurudwara and went inside the Gurudwara to pay obeisance. When he returned, he found his motor cycle missing. Thereafter, on the basis of personal inquiry made by him, he came to know that motor cycle was stolen by Gurpreet Singh @ Gori, applicant Sonu son of Manga Singh, Sandeep Singh and Amandeep Singh. On the basis of said statement, the FIR was registered. After going through the facts of present case, I am of the view that recovery of motor cycle is yet to be effected. Applicant has been named in the FIR. His custodial interrogation is necessary for the recovery of motor cycle. If he is admitted to anticipatory bail, there is every likelihood that he will hamper the process of investigation. Consequently, finding no merits in the present bail application, the same is hereby dismissed. File be consigned to the record room.
