**-:ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT:-1:-**

- (1) The complainant has filed an application under Section 257 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973/ Section 280 of the Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita -2023, seeking permission to withdraw the present complaint on the ground that the matter has been amicably settled between the parties, and the accused has made the full and final payment of the cheque amount along with agreed compensation.
- (2) The complainant has stated that the withdrawal is made voluntarily and without any coercion, pressure, or undue influence.
- (3) Considering the submissions and the fact that the dispute has been resolved, this Court finds no reason to continue the proceedings. Accordingly, the application is allowed.

1. The complainant is permitted to withdraw the complaint.
2. The present complaint stands disposed as **withdrawn**.
3. The accused is acquitted under Section 257 Cr.P.C. / 280 B.N.S.S.
