ORDER

1. Accused-applicant Gobind Singh has filed this application for bail in the above noted case.
2. Notice of this bail application was given to the learned APP for the state who has opposed the bail application.
3. I have heard learned APP for the State as well as learned counsel for the accused/applicant and have gone through the file very carefully.
4. Perusal of the papers shows that FIR of the present case was got lodged for offences under Sections 303(2), 238 and 317(2) of BNS. As per the story of the prosecution, accused Gobind Singh alongwith co-accused has committed theft of one motorcycle bearing registration

number PB-10EW-7485 make Platina and later on he was found in possession of the same. Accused is in Judicial custody since 29.7.2025 and he is not required for any interrogation or recovery. Otherwise, also the guilt of the accused is yet to be established after coming of evidence on merits. Conclusion of trial will take long time. Challan has also been presented in the present case. Hence, no useful purpose is going to be served by detaining the accused behind the bars for an indefinite period. Pre-trial detention is never considered to be in the interest of justice because guilt of accused is yet to be established after coming of evidence on merits. Liberty of human being is not to be taken away on conjectures and surmises. Hence, applicant/accused Gobind Singh is admitted to bail on his furnishing personal bail bonds for a sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety of the like amount subject to the following conditions:

1. That he will not leave the country without the prior permission of the court;
2. That he will not hamper with the prosecution evidence.

Bail bonds and surety bonds have not been furnished. Papers be tagged with the relevant file/FIR.
