Seen the bail petition filed under section 480 BNSS which is preferred by the petitioner, Shri Chandmoni Nath praying therein to allow the accused, Shri Pinku Nath to go on bail in connection with this case under section 93/103(1)/61(2)/3(5) BNS which is corresponding to Howraghat PS case no: 08/ 2026. 2. The accused person named above is in judicial custody in this case since 12/4/2026. 3. The prosecution had alleged that the accused, Shri Pinku Nath and his wife Smti Sumi Nath had entered into a conspiracy and in furtherance of the said conspiracy, they killed their 8 days old daughter on 9/4/2026 by throwing her in a water filled drain, only because of the fact that the accused Shri Pinku Nath did not want a girl child. 4. The learned counsel for the bail petitioner had contended that the accused person may be allowed to go on bail as the chargesheet is already filed in this case and the investigation	

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Continued 9/7/2026	is complete and the accused would not tamper with the investigation or trial. 5. The Ld. Counsel for the bail petitioner has further contended that the accused person is innocent; hence he may be released on bail. 6. The learned P.P had opposed the prayer for bail and submitted that the accused person is prima facie involved in the commission of the alleged offence and there are sufficient materials against him. 7. I have perused the record, and it is seen that the charges under section 103(1)/61(2)/93(3(5) BNS is framed against the accused Shri Pinku Nath and Smti Sumi Nath and the case is set for recording of evidence. 8. Upon perusal of the record, it appears that the principal witnesses in this case are the mother and other relatives as well as the neighbours of the accused Shri Pinku Nath; hence if the accused is released on bail without examining them, then there is likelihood that he might influence these witnesses.

9. It is further seen that the informant in this case **namely Smti Chandmoni Nath** is also the bail petitioner for the accused Shri Pinku Nath; hence influence of the principal witnesses by the accused cannot be ruled out.

10. In view of the above discussions and considering the grave nature of the offence, the prayer for bail of the **accused Shri Pinku Nath is rejected at this stage.**

11. Send a soft copy as well as hard copy of this order to the learned Superintendent of District Jail, Karbi Anglong with a direction to furnish copies of the same to the accused.

12. Accordingly, this bail petition is disposed of.
