ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT-1**

1. Present complaint has been filed by the complainant u/s.138 of Negotiable Instrument Act.
2. From the complainant side, withdrawal pursis has vide Exh.11 has been produced and they declared that they do not want to proceed further with the present case. While the case between the parties is being withdrawn during the Lok Adalat, this court does not deems fit to pass the order for cost in the larger interest of justice with a view to restoration of relations between the parties, considering the principles laid down in Madhya Pradesh State Legal Services Authority Versus Prateek Jain, 2014 (0) AIJEL-SC 55695, Decided on 10/09/2014, Supreme Court of India. In view of the aforesaid, following order is passed.

ORDER

1. The accused stands acquitted for offence under section 138 of the Negotiable Instrument Act.
2. Considering the withdrawal pursis, it is further ordered that any interim application pending on the record stands uncontested disposed off.
3. No order as to cost.
4. Present case is disposed off in Lok Adalat.
