**Sub.: Temporary release of Passport for renew and grant of permission to visit abroad.**

**:- J U D G M E N T :-**

(1) The applicant has filed present application for relaxation of condition no. (f) imposed by the Hon'ble High Court of Gujarat in Criminal Misc. Bail Application No.7766/2019 and to release

passport for one year for renewal of the passport as well as to grant him permission to leave India and to visit foreign countries.

(2) It is submitted by the Ld. advocate for the applicant that in compliance to the order in Cr.M.A. No. 7766/2019 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Gujarat, he is strictly complying with the conditions imposed therein. He has submitted that the applicant is businessman and wants to go to foreign countries for business purpose. He needs his passport for renewal as well as to visit foreign countries for a temporary period, this application has been filed for relaxation of condition nos.(f) imposed by the Hon'ble High Court of Gujarat. Learned Advocate for the applicant has placed on record documents vide Exhibit-3 list of document along with his application. Thus, Ld. advocate appearing for the applicant/accused has prayed to release passport for renewal purpose as well as to visit abroad for the above mentioned period and allow present application. It is further submitted that the applicant had been granted permission to visit abroad by the Hon'ble court many times and he has never breached any of the conditions. It is further submitted that present applicant has very deep roots in the society. There is no chance of fleeing away or running away from the trial. Hence prayed to allow present application.

(3) On the contrary, Ld. APP for the State has objected and opposed the prayers made in the present application by submitting that the case is pending and if the applicant is permitted to travel abroad, then there are chances that the trial may get delayed. Thus, Ld. APP appearing for the State has submitted to dismiss the present application.

(4) I have heard the Ld. Advocates and perused the case file

carefully.

(5) Considering the arguments advanced by both the parties and upon perusal of the list of documents produced on record, it reveals that the applicant was released by the Hon'ble High Court of Gujarat on anticipatory bail vide Cr.M.A No.7766/2019. Perusal of the application reveals that the applicant has prayed for renewal of the passport and has also produced appointment letter dated 23/02/2026. Perusal of the same further reveals that the date of appointment mentioned in the application is 10/03/2026 which is already been expired. So far as the permission to visit abroad for business purpose is concerned i.e. from dated 02/05/2026 to 10/05/2026. Earlier also the applicant has visited out of India and nothing comes on record regarding violation of any of the conditions imposed by the Hon'ble Court. The applicant has abided by all the terms and conditions imposed upon him by the Hon'ble Court. Moreover, the case of applicant is SC No. 29/2021 and this case is on opening of case by prosecution and production of muddmal, as the trial may take a long time to conclude. It is pertinent to note that there is neither incriminating nor adverse reports on record to show or suggest that the applicant has misused his liberty, subsequent to his release on bail. Upon perusal of the papers, there is no record to show that the applicant has misused his liberty or committed breach of any conditions. Thus, after considering the rival submission of both the sides and the documents produced in the matter, this Court is of the view that the present application is hereby partly allowed. Hence, following order is passed.

**-: ORDER :-**

(1) The present CRMA No.154/2026 filed by the applicant

**Rameshbhai Nanjibhai Padshala** stands **partly allowed** with following conditions:

- (A) The concerned Court/I.O./P.S./authority is hereby directed to release the original passport bearing No.Z3786916 of the applicant **from 15/04/2026 to 15/05/2026** subject to the condition that the applicant shall deposit a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lac) with the concerned Court and the said amount shall be returned back to him on his returning back to India and redepositing his Passport;
- (B) The applicant is permitted to leave India for the period from **02/05/2026 to 10/05/2026**;
- (C) Applicant shall duly inform the concerned Police Station/I.O./Court about his itinerary and correct contact addresses with telephone numbers of the places he is likely to visit. The applicant shall submit the xerox copies tickets before going to abroad and the passport to the concerned I.O./court/P.S./authority. Applicant shall, within two days of his return to Bharuch, inform the concerned Police Station/I.O./Court/authority about the same and will scrupulously follow all the conditions imposed while granting him bail.
- (D) The applicant is directed to surrender his passport within **seven days** from the date of return before the concerned Court/I.O./P.S after his arrival at Bharuch and also remain present before the concerned trial court immediately after his arrival.
- (E) The applicant shall file an undertaking before the concerned Court that the trial will not be delayed in his absence and that his Advocate will remain present during his absence

and not seek any adjournment on account of absence of the applicant and concerned Learned Advocate of the applicant would proceed further with the matter and shall also not take any objection regarding identification.

- (F) Accordingly, the condition nos. (f) imposed in the order passed in Cr.M.A. No.7766/2019 stands suspended/modified from **15/04/2026 to 15/05/2026** or till actual return, whichever is earlier. However, the applicant shall not misuse the liberty granted in his favour.
- (G) The other terms and conditions imposed in Cr.M.A. (Anti.) No.7766/2019, shall remain unaltered.
- Yadi of this order be sent to the concerned Court/Police Station/Office of the opponent.
