-: J U D G M E N T :-

[1] The present application has been made by the applicant accused seeking temporary bail for 30 days in the matter of Sessions Case No. 07/2026 registered pursuant to the FIR bearing I-CR No. 11214023251735/2025 registered with Kadodara GIDC Police Station for the offences punishable under Sections 103(1), 351(3), 352 of BNS and section 135 of G.P. Act.

[2] Ld. Advocate appearing for the applicant has submitted that the present applicant is in judicial custody since long time, he is innocent and has not committed any offence. It is submitted that there is no *prima facie* case made out against the present applicant. It is further submitted that there is no one in the family to look after his family and has responsibility of his wife and two children. It is further submitted that due to lack of money, his family condition is very bad. Based on the above grounds, the Ld. Adv. prayed to allow the present application.

[3] Ld. APP appearing for State has filed affidavit of Investigating Officer vide Exh.4. It is vehemently argued by the Ld. APP that the Sessions Cases is pending against the accused. The accused is habituated to file such applications. Based on above arguments, it is prayed to dismiss the application.

[4] Heard Ld. Advocates for the parties. Perused application, affidavit of I.O. along with papers produced on record.

[5] Perusing the police papers it appears that the accused is facing charges under Section 103(1), 351(3), 352 of BNS and section 135 of G.P. Act. The reason cited for releasing the accused on temporary bail is that he has responsibility of his family and financial condition of his family is very bad and due to financial difficulties he has filed this application. However, the reason cited by the applicant does not found to be reasonable and also it does not inspire confidence. He had committed very grave offence of murder. Moreover, if he released on temporary bail, he may try to hamper with the evidence and there are chances that

he may give threat to the witnesses. Based on above discussion, as the present application is devoid of any merit, I do not deem it fit to exercise discretion in favour of the present applicant and hence, I pass the following final order.

-: ORDER :-

Present Criminal Misc. (Temporary Bail) Application No. 233 of 2026 of applicant namely **SHARAD ALIAS AKSHAY DAGDU BODA DHANGAR** filed under Section 483 of BNSS, 2023 is hereby rejected.
