JUDGMENT:

The accused named above has been sent up to this Court for trial by the Station House Officer of Police Post, Balongi for allegedly committed the offence punishable under Section 188 of IPC, on the allegations that on 14.07.2019 in the area of Balongi, accused was found disobeying an order dated 27.05.2019 duly promulgated by public servant District Magistrate, Mohali, vide which the same was prohibited. During the course of investigation, the accused was arrested, statements of the witnesses were recorded and after the completion of investigation, challan was presented in the Court.

2. On presentation of challan, copies of challan were supplied to the accused free of costs, as envisaged U/s 207 Cr.P.C.

3. Finding a prima-facie case **U/s. 188 of IPC**, offence has been made out against the accused, accused was charge sheeted **under section 188 IPC** to which the accused pleaded guilty and did not claim trial.

4. I have gone through the record as well as the confession made by the accused with his free will, which is without any kind of threat, greed, coercion and undue pressure from anyone. Before the confession made by the accused, the undersigned has explained to the accused that he is not bound to make the confession of his guilt and if he makes so, the same will be read in evidence against him. I am satisfied that the accused has confessed his guilt without any pressure, undue influence, threat or promise of any kind. In view of the voluntary confession made by the accused, I hold him guilty for an offence punishable **U/s 188 of IPC** and he is convicted there-under. Let he be taken in to custody and be heard on the quantum of sentence.

QUANTUM OF SENTENCE

5. I have heard the convict on the quantum of sentence. Convict submitted that he is a poor man. He also submitted that he is the first time offender and is to look after his family members. He is the only bread earner of the family. He also undertook not to do any such act in future. Heard. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case as well as the nature of the offence and the plea taken by the convict, I am of the considered opinion that the sentence of fine would meet the ends of justice, therefore, the convict is ordered to pay a fine of **Rs.200/-** and in default of payment of fine to undergo **SI for 07 days**. Fine deposited. Case property, if any, be dealt with as per rules. File be consigned to the record room
