An application for modification in condition

::JUDGMENT ::

1. The applicant who has been granted anticipatory bail for the offences alleged to have been committed under Sections 406, 420 & 114 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 [for short “IPC”] registered with Gotri Police Station vide I CR No.146/2014, has preferred this application under

Section 439(b) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 [for short “CrPC] with a prayer to modify condition no.2(1) being not to leave the revenue limits of the State of Gujarat without prior permission of the concerned Court, imposed by the Court in its order dated 14/06/2014 passed in Criminal Misc. Application No.1050 of 2014.

2. Pursuant to the issuance of notice, Ld.PP Mr.AM Desai has caused appearance, and Police Inspector of Gotri Police Station, Vadodara, has submitted report vide Exh.4.
3. Heard Ld.Advocate Mr.BR Macchi appearing for the applicant who has reiterated the averments of the application. In addition, Ld.Advocate has submitted that while enlarging the applicant on anticipatory bail, the Court has imposed a condition upon him not to leave the revenue limits of the State of Gujarat without prior permission of the concerned Court. It is submitted that the relatives of the applicant reside out of the State of Gujarat, and that the applicant is engaged in the business of land development. Thus, for the purpose of his business, the applicant is required to leave the territory of the State of Gujarat off and on. It is therefore submitted to modify the said condition, and thereby, the applicant be prohibited from leaving India without prior permission of the Court.
4. Heard Ld.PP Mr.AM Desai appearing for the State of Gujarat who has resisted the present application in

consonance with the report submitted by the IO vide Exh.4.

5. Heard Ld.Advocates for the parties and perused the papers.
6. Considering the fact that the applicant herein is a businessman engaged in the work of land development, he is required to leave the territorial limits of the State of Gujarat, frequently. Having regard to the above aspect, I am inclined to allow the present application. Hence, following order is passed:

:: ORDER ::

- (1) The present application is hereby allowed.
- (2) **Condition no.2(1) imposed by the Court in its order dated 04/06/2014 passed in Criminal Misc. Application No.1050 of 2014 is modified to the effect that “the applicant shall not leave the territory of India without prior permission of the concerned Court”.**
- (3) Remaining conditions shall remain unaltered.
- (4) Concerned Police station be informed accordingly.
