ORDER

1. Vide instant order, this court shall dispose of bail application filed by the accused/applicant Kanwaljit Singh under Section 439 Cr.P.C in the above noted case.

2. Notice of the bail application was issued and police record perused.

3. It is submitted by ld.counsel for the applicant that the applicant has been falsely implicated in the case in hand. He further submitted that recovery has already been effected and applicant is in custody since the date of his arrest i.e. 25.6.2021. Accordingly, he has prayed for concession of bail to the applicant.

4. Per contra, Ld. Addl. PP for the State has opposed the bail application and prayed for its dismissal.

5. Heard. Perusal of police record produced before the court reflects that recovery of 16 gram smack contained in a polythene was effected from the applicant/accused on 25.6.2021, which falls in non-

commercial quantity. The applicant/accused is in custody since the date of his arrest i.e., 25.6.2021. Recovery has already been effected. It is evident that culmination of investigation and presentation of challan shall take long time, where as no useful purpose would be served by keeping the applicant in custody. Accordingly, the bail application moved by the accused/applicant stands allowed on furnishing of his personal bonds in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with one surety in the like amount, to the satisfaction of Ilqa/ Duty Magistrate subject to the conditions that the accused will not try to tamper with the prosecution evidence in any manner, will not leave the country without prior permission of the court, will appear on each and every date of hearing. The Duty/Ilqa Magistrate is directed to send the bonds to this court after acceptance for being attached with case file. Papers be attached with the main file/challan whenever same shall be presented.
