Heard on the bail application filed by counsel for applicant-accused Jagdeep Masih @ Jagga. It is alleged in the application that the applicant-accused has been falsely implicated in the present FIR. He is innocent and has not committed any offence.

Notice of bail application was issued to State, however, learned APP for the State did not file reply but opposed the bail application.

The applicant-accused is in custody since 08.04.2022 and the recovery has already been effected. Challan is yet to be presented. Therefore, the conclusion of trial will take considerable time. Presence of the accused-applicant is only required for the purpose of trial and he

is no more required for investigation. No useful purpose would be served by detaining the accused further in judicial custody and same will be burden on the State exchequer. Accordingly, without commenting the merit of this case, bail application stands **allowed** and applicant-accused **Jagdeep Masih @ Jagga** is admitted to bail, subject to furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with one surety in the like amount as well as subject to following conditions:-

- A. That accused shall attend the court proceeding on each and every date of hearing.
- B. That accused shall not commit an offence similar to the offence of which he is accused, or suspected, of the commission of which he is suspected, and
- C. That accused shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer or temper with the evidence,
- D. That accused shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court.

Requisite bail bonds and surety bonds not furnished. Papers be attached with remand papers.
