

Raja Singh etc. versus State of Punjab

Police record received. The counsel for the petitioners submitted that the only offence under Section 452 IPC is non-bailable and the other offences are under Section 506/323/34 of Indian Penal Code. The offence under Section 452 IPC is added only to make the offence non-bailable. The petitioner is ready to join the investigation. He prayed for adinterim bail.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, I deem it appropriate to grant ad-interim bail to the petitioners. The applicants-accused are directed to join investigation within 7 days from today and upon their doing so, they will be released on interim bail by the arresting/investigating officer, subject to the condition that the applicants-accused shall continue to join investigation as and when called by the investigating officer and shall co-operate in the same. The applicants shall comply with terms 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Matter be put upon 16.9.2019 for further consideration.
Police record be produced again for evaluating the outcome of the investigation.
