ORDER

Police record has been produced by ASI Ramesh Masih from Police Station Sadar Ferozepur, which has been seen and returned. The applicant was arrested in this case on 21.10.2018. Now he is in judicial custody. Arguments on bail application heard.

2. FIR of this case was lodged by complainant Nidhi Sukhije wife of Ashish Kumar, resident of Basti Hazoor Singh, Fazika with the allegations that she was working as a teacher in

Government Middle School, Hassan Dhutt. On 07.08.2018, after school hours, at about 02.15 PM, she along with her colleague Samita Shukla was coming towards village Khai PHEME KE on Activa scooter, which was being driven by her colleague Samita Shukla. When they reached about half kilometer ahead of their school, a young person in the age group of 25 years came from behind on a motorcycle and snatched purse of the complainant, which contained a mobile phone make Samsung, Identity Card, Bus Pass, keys of her house and school premises. In the process of snatching, Active scooter fell down, due to which the complainant and her colleague received injuries. A prayer was made for taking action against the said miscreants.

3. The police record further shows that recovery has already been effected. The applicant was not named in the FIR. His name figured as an accused during investigation.

4. As pointed out above, the recovery has already been effected. The applicant was arrested in this case on 21.10.2018. Now he in judicial custody. The conclusion of trial will take time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping him in jail, rather it would be a burden on State Exchequer. So, the applicant is ordered to be released on bail in the above referred FIR, on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 25,000/- with one surety in the like amount, subject to satisfaction of learned Illaqa/Duty Magistrate, Ferozepur. A copy of this order be sent to concerned court. Bail application file be consigned to the record room.
