

BA-251-25 Laxman Singh Vs. State of Punjab

Heard on bail application filed on behalf of applicant/accused ***Laxman Singh*** in FIR No.189 dated 24.11.2025 under Sections 115(1)/115(2)/324(2)/191(3)/190 of BNS, registered at P.S. Sadar Jalalabad.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for applicant/accused that the facts mentioned in the FIR are false and frivolous and applicant/accused has been falsely implicated in the present case. The FIR in question is result of politically vendetta. The applicant/accused is innocent and law abiding citizen of India. Nothing has been recovered from the applicant/accused. The applicant/accused is ready to furnish bail bonds. The applicant/accused is in judicial custody since the day of his arrest. Lastly, he prayed that the applicant/accused may kindly be released on bail.

Upon notice, learned APP for the State opposed the bail application orally.

According to the contents of the FIR, on 15.11.2025 complainant Bohar Singh alongwith his nephew namely Lovepreet Singh was cultivating the land with the help of Tractor make Swaraj. Laxman Singh alongwith his co-accused armed with Dangs, Sotas, Kirpans, Kulhari etc. was arguing with Lovepreet Singh. On hearing raula, complainant reached there and accused Laxman Singh gave Kulhari blows to complainant and others also attacked upon complainant. Laxman Singh in-connivance with other accused injuries

to complainant. Accused has been in custody since 11.12.2025. No medical record with regard to receiving injuries by complainant and injured produced in the court as challan in the above-noted FIR has not been presented yet. Moreover, except offence under Section 118(1) of BNS other offences are bailable in nature. Therefore, no purpose would be served by keeping the applicant/accused behind for bar for an indefinite period. The presentation of challan and its conclusion shall take sufficient time. Accordingly, accused ***Laxman Singh*** is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.37,000/- with one surety of the like amount and subject to the following conditions:-

1. He shall appear on each and every date of hearing without any notice.
2. He shall not leave the country without prior permission of this court.
3. He shall not induce or dissuade the prosecution witnesses in any manner.

Bail bonds/surety bonds not furnished. Bail application be attached with the remand papers.
