

Mandeep Singh Versus State of Punjab

FIR No.63 dated 31.05.2023

Under section 457, 380, 411 of IPC

Heard on first bail application under section 437 Cr.P.C moved on behalf of applicant/accused Mandeep Singh. It is averred in the application that challan has already been presented by the police in this court. Applicant/accused had not committed any offence as alleged in the FIR and statement of the prosecution. Accused/applicant is innocent. It will take a long time to conclude the trial of the case. No useful purpose will be served to keep the accused/applicant behind the bars. Prosecution witnesses have already been examined so there is no fear of tampering with the PW's. Applicant/accused has never taken any part in illegal activities and has full faith in the law. Accused/applicant will not leave India without the prior permission of the Court. He is only bread winner of his family. His parents are old age and they are dependent upon the applicant/accused. Prayer is made to allow the application.

Notice of the application is given to Learned APP for the State who opposed the same by filing reply that accused/applicant along with other co-accused entered in the house of the complainant Ankush Kumar Gupta and stolen gold and silver ornament and Rs.2,50,000/- cash from the house of the complainant and the police of PS Gidderbaha recovered one gold brick and two pairs of silver anklets from the accused/applicant. Accused/applicant is required to be kept in judicial lockup in order to save the evidence. Prayer is made to dismiss the application.

Applicant/accused is not required for further investigation. Criminality of applicant/accused can be determined only after appreciation of evidence led by parties. No useful purpose would be served by keeping accused behind the bars for further period. So, in these circumstances, present

application is allowed. Applicant/accused Mandeep Singh is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds in sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount. Requisite bail bonds and surety bonds not furnished. Papers be tagged with remand papers.
