ORDER :-

The present bail application has been filed by accused-applicant under section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in the above noted FIR with the contentions that accused-applicant is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case as the complainant and the applicant were known to each other and were having friendship but under the influence of her parents , the complainant had made false allegations against the applicant and on the basis of wrong facts this FIR has been registered. The FIR was registered against the brother and the wife of the brother of accused-applicant, but lateron they were found innocent and were exonerated. The challan against the accused-applicant is presented. He was arrested in this case on 01.02.2020 and since then he is in judicial custody. The trial will take

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considerable long time to conclude and prayer has been made for releasing the accused-applicant on bail.

2. Notice of the bail application was given to Addl. P.P. for the State, who put her appearance and opposed the bail application.

3. Record received and perused. From the perusal of the record shows that present FIR has been lodged on the statement of victim with the contentions that present accused-applicant has firstly kidnapped the victim and then took her to the house of his brother, where the victim was kept for a night and she was raped by the accused-applicant against her wishes. The victim is aged about 14 ½ years at the time of occurrence and even in her statement under section 164 Cr.P.C., before the learned Magistrate, the victim has levelled specific allegations against the present accused-applicant. The case is at initial stage. The victim is yet to be examined. The allegations are serious in nature against the present accused-applicant. There are every chances that accused-applicant can tamper with the prosecution evidence, if he is released on bail. Accordingly, I do not find any merits in the bail application. Hence, the present bail application is hereby dismissed. Police record returned and bail application be consigned.
