O R D E R

Trial court record has been received and perused. **Arguments have been heard** on anticipatory bail application of the aforesaid applicant /accused Ajit Singh, who has been summoned in a complaint case titled as 'Jugraj Singh Vs. Sher Singh & Ors.', preferred by complainant Jugraj Singh before the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Kapurthala, vide order dated 03.09.2022.

Since, the applicant/ accused Ajit Singh has been summoned in a private complaint, so, nothing is to be recovered from his possession. Thus, the custodial interrogation of applicant/ accused Ajit Singh is not warranted in any manner, rather his formal presence is required to face trial by him before the learned trial court. Therefore, he is entitled to the concession of exceptional circumstances *i.e.* anticipatory bail.

Consequently, the present applicant/ accused Ajit Singh is, hereby, directed to surrender before the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate within **10 days from today** and on his surrendering, he will be admitted on bail on furnishing the bail bonds and surety bonds subject to the satisfaction of Trial Court/ Duty Magistrate. Failing to comply this order within that prescribed period by the applicant/ accused, this order of bail shall stand automatically vacated of bail to him. Trial court record along-with copy of this order be sent to the concerned quarter. For further proceedings, file be put up before this court on 23.01.2023.
