

State Vs. Mango Devi, wife of Khushia Ram alias Khushia, resident of street No.1, Bangi Nagar, Amarpura Basti, Bathinda.

Bail application under Section 483 of BNSS

ORDER:

1. First post arrest bail application filed by the petitioner under Section 483 BNSS in case FIR No.118 dated 21.05.2025, under Section 21(b) of NDPS Act, Canal Colony, Bathinda considered.
2. Summary of the case of the prosecution is that in a chance recovery, 06 grams Heroin along with polythene was recovered from the petitioner.
3. Case of the petitioner is that she has been falsely implicated. The alleged recovery has already been effected. She is in custody since 21.05.2025 and not a previous offender. While on the other hand, Ld. Addl. PP for the State contested the bail application by submitting that offence in question is serious one.
4. I have considered the rival submissions.

5. Petitioner is in custody since 21.05.2025. Alleged recovery has already been effected, which falls under the non-commercial quantity. As per the record produced by the IO, petitioner is not a previous offender. It is also not the case of the prosecution that petitioner, if released on bail, would influence the witnesses or flee the trial.

6. In view of factual circumstances of the case, the bail application of petitioner succeeds and petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, subject to the conditions laid down under Section 437(3) and 439(2) Cr.P.C.

7. Copy of this order be sent to the quarter concerned. Bail application file be attached with the main file/remand papers.
