OPDER

The present bail application has been filed under Section 483 BNSS. Learned counsel for the applicant/accused submitted that accused could not appear before the Court on 03.10.2022 due to reason of misunderstanding of date and due to his absence his nonailable warrants have been issued. Later on, he was declared proclaimed offender by the

learned Trial Court vide order dated 01.07.2023. The accused himself surrendered before the Court on 05.11.2024 and since then he is in custody in this case. Earlier also accused granted bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. by the Hon'ble High Court vide its order dated 06.11.2019 and that order is still intact. The absence of accused is neither willful nor intentional. He is ready to abide by all the terms and conditions to be imposed by the Court. Thus, it is prayed that applicant/accused be admitted to bail.

2. Contesting the arguments learned PP submitted that the accused submitted that accused was declared proclaimed person in the present case during the trial of the case and thereafter he surrendered before the Court on 05.11.2024. But keeping in view of the gravity and seriousness of the offence, accused is not entitled to bail.

3. **After hearing the rival contentions** of the parties and perusing the file, accused is entitled to benefit of bail in the present case. The accused was declared proclaimed person on 01.07.2023 in the present case and thereafter he surrendered in the Court on 05.11.2024. Since then accused has been behind the bars for about two months. He must have learnt a lesson for jumping bail. No useful purpose would be served by keeping the applicant/accused behind the bars. Moreover accused would be a burden on the State Exchequer and no work can be taken from him under the rules in the jail. Accordingly, this bail application stands allowed and applicant/ accused **Jagmeet Singh** be admitted to bail on his furnishing personal bail bond in the sum of **Rs.50,000/-** with one

surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of learned Illaqa/Duty Magistrate, subject to the following conditions:-

1. That he will not tamper with the prosecution evidence;
2. That he will appear in the court on each and every date of hearing to be fixed in the trial;
3. That he will not leave the territory of India without prior permission of the Court;

Learned Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate is also directed to accept the cash surety if presented by the accused. Copy of this order be sent to the learned Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate for compliance. Bail bonds/surety bonds, so furnished be returned to this Court and the same be attached with the main file. Copy of this order be also sent to the Superintendent, Central Jail, Kapurthala through email for intimation and necessary action, if any. This bail application file be attached with main file.
