ORDER

1. File put up before me being Vacation Judge as learned Presiding Officer is availing summer vacation.

2. Vide separate statement recorded before the court it is stated by ASI Balkar Singh No. 1340/PTK, P.S. Dinanagar that applicant/accused has joined the investigation on 05.06.2026 as per the order dated 01.06.2026 passed by the Court of Sh. Vineet Kumar Narang, Ld. Additional Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur. He further stated that the custodial interrogation of applicant/accused is not required by the police. Since, in accordance with order dated 01.06.2026 passed by aforesaid court, whereby the accused/applicant has been granted interim bail and was directed to join the investigation of the case to the satisfaction of the IO/SHO/arresting officer, the applicant has joined the investigation, the order dated 01.06.2026 is, hereby, made absolute and application filed by the applicant under Section 482 (2) of BNSS is allowed, subject to the conditions as mentioned in order dated 01.06.2026.

3. In case the applicant/accused misuses the concession of bail by absenting from the proceedings, the trial court shall be at liberty to cancel this bail order. Police record be returned and bail application file be attached with the main file. File be sent back to the concerned court immediately for consignment purposes.
