

Order Below Exh. 01

The Brief Fact of the application is that the amount of applicant is frozen in the bank account because the said amount is seized by the Cyber Crime Police under section : 102 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 as per the complaint made by the applicant on toll free number 1930. In this regard the FIR was not lodged by the Police. During the Inquiry the Total Amount of Rupees **11,000/-** is frozen from different bank account. No any claim is filed during the said proceedings. Police has filed details opinion that they have no any objection if the amount is so released. So, that in the larger interest of justice the following order is to pass:

:: O R D E R ::

- The present application is hereby allowed.
- The amount of **Rs. 11,000/-** which is frozen by the different bank mentioned in the application is ordered to release and return to applicant by taking bond and one surety of likewise amount.
- The bond and surety is given in the concern police station.
- After receiving bond and surety from applicant it is hereby ordered to police send yadi to concerned bank with all details of bank account number and details of amount with name of account holders.
- If Any mischief is found during the said proceeding then it is the liability to applicant and the applicant is hereby ordered that the release amount will be deposited in the court.
