

**ORDER BELOW APPLICATION EXH.4 (FOR SUSPENSION OF SENTENCE)
IN CRIMINAL APPEAL NO.02 OF 2026**

1. The present application is filed by the applicants - **Shri DHUKHARAM PUNMARAM CHAUDHARI, PIRARAM HARDANARAM CHAUDHARI** and **MAHADEV TREDING COMPANY (Seller's Firm)** for suspension of sentence in connection with the conviction recorded vide judgment and order dtd. 23.12.2025 in Criminal Case No. 270/2019 by the learned Judicial Magistrate F.C, Dharampur and also prayed to enlarge the applicant on bail.
2. Heard Mrs. P.N.BHANUSHALI, learned Advocate appearing for the applicant and I have also heard the learned A.P.P. Mr.B.R.Prajapati for the the respondent state.
3. I have heard the learned Advocate Mrs.P.N.BHANUSHALI for the appellant. I have perused the application filed by the appellant for suspension of sentence as well as appeal filed by the applicant. Considering the argument, considering the circumstances of the present case, the charge leveled against the applicant and considering the settled principle of law. I pass the following order.

ORDER

1. The present application is hereby allowed.
2. As per Section 430(1) of the Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita,2023 pending hearing and final disposal of aforesaid

Criminal Appeal, the order of sentence imposed upon the applicant in the judgment and order passed in Criminal Case No.270/2019 dtd. 23.12.2025 by the learned Judicial Magistrate F.C, Dharampur is hereby suspended till the final disposal of the criminal appeal filed against this judgment.

3. The Applicant / appellants are hereby ordered to be released on bail upon furnishing surety of **Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand only)** each and personal bond of like amount to the Trial Court, (as record and proceedings of this case are there) till the final disposal of the criminal appeal filed against the judgment and order passed in Criminal Case No. 270/2019, dtd. 23.12.2025 by the learned Judicial Magistrate F.C, Dharampur.
4. It is further directed to the applicant / appellants that they may regularly attend the court during the course of hearing of the appeal.
5. The applicant / appellants shall furnish his mobile/contact number and residential address with authenticated proof before the Court at the time of execution of the bond and shall not change their contact number or address without prior permission of this Court.
