Order Below Ex-1

In view of compromise pursis vide **Ex-12** signed and submitted by Ld. Advocates for the parties, this claim petition stands disposed of today in **National Lok Adalat held on 11.07.2026.**

As per the said compromise pursis, total amount of **Rs.26,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty Six Lakh Only)** is ordered to be deposited in this Tribunal by the opponent - Insurance Company.

The opponent insurance company shall deposit the aforesaid amount within a period of three months from the date of the receipt of certified copies of the award.

After deducting the amount of court fees and interim amount of compensation paid U/s.140 of the M. V. Act, 60% of the amount of compensation be fixed deposit in any Nationalized Bank to the choice of the claimants for a period of 5 (five) years and remaining 40% amount to be paid through RTGS or NEFT mode, upon proper verification and identification. If the claimant(s) is/are senior citizen then the Bank shall after obtaining the proof of age, deposit the said amount in a scheme of senior citizen. The interest on the fixed deposit investment as and when it becomes due will be paid to the claimant(s).

Thereafter, the remaining award amount shall be distributed in the ratio of **45:15:15:15:05:05** to the claimant nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 & 6 respectively.

The total amount coming in the hands of the minor applicant Nos. 2 to 4 shall be invested as fixed deposit (F.D.) in the name of the minors applicant Nos. 2 to 4 through the applicant No.1 (Mother) in any Nationalized bank of choice of the applicant No.1 for a period of five years or till the period the minor applicant Nos. 2 to 4 attains majority, whichever is later.

The Bank is directed that no loan or facility of cash-credit or overdraft or likewise be allowed on this amount of fixed deposit. The amount invested in fixed deposit is also not subject to the withdrawal prior to its maturity or without prior permission of this Tribunal.

The Insurance Company is directed to deposit the Award amount with interest as per the direction given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Writ Petition(s) (Civil) No.534/2020 through RTGS or NEFT mode in the Bank Account of of this Tribunal. The detail of the Bank Account of this Tribunal are as under:-

After deposited the awarded amount in this account, the Insurance Company shall inform and send the copy of said Bank advice to the MAC Tribunal through e-mail I.D. i.e. macp-Dharampur@gujarat.gov.in.

The claimant(s) shall provide the details of PAN Card, Aadhaar Card & Saving Bank Account for transfer of compensation as per the direction given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Writ Petition(s) (Civil) No.534/2020.

As per the provision of Section 21(1), Chapter-VI of the Legal Services Authority Act, 1987, Court Fee Stamp shall not be deducted as this application is settled in National Lok-Adalat, and if Court Fee paid in such case, shall be refunded under Sub-Section(1) of Section 20 in the manner provided under the Court Fee Act, 1870.
