

The present suit has filed for permanent injunction. Along with plaint, I.A. No. 1 has been filed under order 39 Rule 1 and 2 of CPC by seeking ex parte order of temporary injunction restraining the defendants from telecasting/publishing any defamatory/malicious/scandalous news items as against the plaintiff in relation to residential/house property bearing No.29, Old No.25/C, with PID No.70-45-29 within the jurisdiction of BBMP Ward No.117, Old No.70, Bangiyappa Garden, Akkithimanahalli, Shantinagar, Bengaluru and as against any of the reckless, malicious, scandalous allegations made by Sri. Rajakumar in relation to O.S. No.1020/2024 pending on the file of 2nd Addl. City Civil and Sessions Judge, Bengaluru in their respective news channels/you tube channels/face book page or in any other form of social media of the defendants and in daily news papers as against the plaintiff, pending disposal of the suit.

After hearing the counsel for plaintiffs and on perusal of affidavit enclosed to I.A. No. 1 and documents produced along with plaint, I am of the view at this stage, the plaintiffs have

made out a prima-facie case and case of urgency for grant an exparte temporary injunction against the defendants as prayed in the I.A. No. 1 and as otherwise the object of grant the injunction would be defeated by the delay. Hence, I am constrain to pass the following:

ORDER

Issue ex-parte order of temporary injunction restraining the defendants from further telecasting/publishing any defamatory/malicious/scandalous news items as against the plaintiffs in relation to residential/house property bearing No.29, Old No.25/C, with PID No.70-45-29 within the jurisdiction of BBMP Ward No.117, Old No.70, Bangiyappa Garden, Akkithimanahalli, Shantinagar, Bengaluru and as against any of the reckless, malicious, scandalous allegations made by Sri. Rajakumar in relation to O.S. No.1020/2024 pending on the file of 2nd Addl. City Civil and Sessions Judge, Bengaluru in their respective news channels/you tube channels/face book page or in any other form of social media of the defendants and in daily news papers as against the plaintiffs till next date of hearing.

The plaintiffs shall comply order 39 Rule 3(a) of CPC.

After compliance of order 39 Rule 3(a) of CPC, the office is hereby directed to issue T.I order, suit summons and notice on IA No.1 to the defendants r/by 14/03/2024.
