Examination-in-chief by P.P. for the State :

I know CW- 5 and 7. I know the accused before the court who is appearing through V.C. About 8 years back myself, CW- 5 and 7 have talked with the accused for purchasing the scrap stored in Nayak Layout. We went to the said place at about 12 midnight in a Tata Ace vehicle. The accused allowed us to come inside the gate and asked to stay in the night so that they can take scrap in the morning. We went to sleep in the vehicle brought by us. The accused came to us at about 5a.m. and asked us to take the scrap and he was frightened. We took

the scrap identified by the accused before the court by paying Rs.8000. After two days police called to me in the police station and shown the accused before the court. We have identified the accused before the court from whom we have purchased the scrap. Police told us that the accused has committed murder of watchman in the shed. I have given statement before the police.

Cross-examination by advocate for accused:

Counsel for accused called out, absent. The accused who is in VC was informed about his counsel not appearing in the case not cross examining the witnesses and he can cross examine the witness. The accused submits that his counsel will appear and cross examine the witness. No grounds to grant time. Hence it is treated that accused has no cross examination to the witness.
