Examination-in-chief by P.P. for the State :

I have been working as Casualty Medical Officer in Kempegowda Institute of Medical Sciences Hospital and Research Center, Bengaluru since March 2019.

2. On 31.8.2020 at 8.30 p.m., when I was on duty in Casualty department of KIMS Hospital, a patient by name Appu, aged 25 years came to the hospital accompanied by P.C. No.17952 for treatment with history of assault.

3. On examination of the said person I had found following injuries on his person:

1. 2 cut lacerated wounds present over the posterior aspect of head.
2. 2 cut lacerated wounds present over the left side of the face.
3. 2 cut lacerated wounds, one over the right middle finger and one over the left little finger.

4. All those injuries were simple in nature. I have issued a wound certificate pertaining to the said person. The document shown to me now is the concerned wound certificate issued by me. The document identified by the witness is marked as Ex.P 5. This document bears my signature. The signature of the witness is marked as Ex.P 5(a).

5. In my opinion the injuries mentioned in Ex.P 5 may be caused on account of assault with the weapon marked as M.O.No. 3.

Advocate for A-1 absent. A-1 submits that he not going to cross examine the witness. Hence cross examination of this witness on the side of A-1 is taken as nil.
