Regular APP for the State is on leave today.

This is an application under Section 480 of BNSS for grant of bail on behalf of applicant/accused namely Aditya S/o Sh. Kishanveer Singh.

Present: Sh. Bhavesh Verma, Ld. Sub. APP for the State.

1. This order shall dispose of bail application under section 480 BNSS filed by the applicant/accused **Aditya**, for seeking the regular bail. It is submitted by the Ld. Counsel for the applicant that the accused is innocent and he is in JC since 04.06.2026 and there is no further requirement of accused for investigation. It is further submitted that co-accused person is already granted bail and the accused will appear before this court as and when required.
2. Ld. Sub. APP has strongly opposed the bail application on the ground of recurrence of similar offence and apprehension of threat to the complainant. He further submits that if the accused is released on bail he may evade trial.
3. Heard. Record perused.
4. In the present case, accused/applicant **Aditya** has been booked under Section 303(2)/317(2)/3(5) BNS. No investigation qua the accused is pending. Thus, no purpose would be served by keeping the accused in further judicial custody. Also, conclusion of trial may take long time and it is trite preposition of law that pre-trial detention should be minimal.

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5. Accordingly, this court deems it appropriate to release the accused *Aditya* in present FIR upon furnishing personal and surety bond to the tune of Rs.15,000/- each to the satisfaction of the undersigned/ Duty JMFC. The accused is also directed not to directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or tamper with the evidence and shall not commit similar offence in future and shall face the trial regularly. In case of breach of any conditions mentioned above, the IO is at liberty to move appropriate application for cancellation of bail of the applicant/accused. Accordingly, the present application stands allowed.

6. Nothing contained herein shall have bearing, adverse or otherwise on the merits of this case.

7. Copy of this order be given dasti to the Ld. counsel for the accused/applicant and copy be sent to Jail Superintendent concerned for compliance. Another copy be also sent to the accused through Jail Superintendent concerned.
