2. Whether the description of the suit schedule property is correct?
3. Whether the plaintiff proves that it is the owner of the suit schedule property so described in the plaint, as alleged?
4. If so, whether the plaintiff is entitled for eviction of the suit schedule property, as prayed?
5. Whether the plaintiff further proves that the alleged attempt of inducting 3rd persons into the possession of the suit schedule property or any part thereof by the defendants, as alleged?
6. Whether the defendants prove that the very filing of suit is fraud on the part of the court as well as on them, as contended in their written statement?
7. Whether the defendants prove that after demise of Shankar Dixit they remained in possession of the suit schedule property and exercising the right of ownership over the

same, as contended in their written statement?

8. Whether the plaintiff further proves that the very act of the defendants is illegal, as alleged?
9. Whether the plaintiff is entitled for the possession, as claimed?
10. Whether the plaintiff is entitled for the relief of permanent injunction as claimed?
11. What order or decree?
