- 1) Whether the plaintiff proves that her mother Smt. Kantha is legally wedded wife of deceased K. Ashwathama?
- 2) Whether the plaintiff proves that due to wed-lock of K. Ashwathama and Smt. Kantha, she born to them?
- 3) Whether the plaintiff proves that suit schedule properties are the joint family properties?
- 4) Whether the plaintiff proves that the defendants have created documents in-respect of suit schedule properties and these documents are not binding on her share in the suit schedule properties?
- 5) Whether the defendants 1 to 4 prove that the defendant No.1 is legally wedded wife of deceased K. Ashwathama and defendants 2 to 4 are their children?
- 6) Whether the defendants 1 to 4 prove that item No.1 was self acquired property of deceased K. Ashwathama, during his life time he had gifted the same in favour of

the defendant No.1 by way of registered gift deed dated 12.04.1992?

- 7) Whether the defendants prove that item No.2 was self-acquired property of deceased K. Ashwathama and during his life time, for his need and to purchase of the properties, he and his sons sold the same to the defendants 5 and 6?
- 8) Whether the defendants 1 to 4 prove that item No.3 is self-acquired property of the defendant No.2?
- 9) Whether the defendants prove that suit of the plaintiff is not maintainable?
- 10) Whether the plaintiff is entitle for relief of partition and separate possession?
- 11) Whether the plaintiff is entitle for enquiry into mesne profits?
- 12) Whether the plaintiff is entitle for declaration in-respect of gift deed dated 28.02.2002?
- 13) What order or decree?
