The plaintiff has filed an application I.A.No.I under Order I Rule 8 R/w Sec.151 of Code of Civil Procedure.

Heard.

I.A. No.I under Order I Rule 8 R/w Sec.151 of Code of Civil Procedure is allowed permitting the plaintiff association to represent and sue the defendants on behalf of all the members of the plaintiff association.

Heard on I.A. No.II under Order XXXIX Rules 1 and 2 of Code of Civil Procedure. The plaintiff has sought Ad-interim order of exparte temporary injunction restraining the defendants or any persons claiming through them from interfering with in any manner and disturbing the plaintiff association's possession and enjoyment of the suit schedule properties till the disposal of the suit. To support the said contention, plaintiff has produced the necessary documents. At present, the plaintiff has made out prima facie case to grant exparte temporary injunction. If the notice is to be ordered, the delay would

be defeated for the purpose of filing this suit. Hence, ex parte temporary injunction is granted against the defendants in respect of the suit schedule properties as prayed in I.A. No.11 till next date of hearing.

The plaintiff shall comply under Order XXXIX Rule 3 CPC.
