

Case is advanced.

The petitioner and her counsel present and filed Joint memo and the matter is settled for **Rs.12,00,000/- (Rupees Twelve Lakhs Only)** as full and final settlement. The Joint Memo is duly signed by both the parties and their counsels. The contents of Joint memo are read over and explained to the petitioner and she has admitted that it is accepted voluntary.

The counsel for petitioner identified the petitioner. The identification of petitioner is verified by going through the original Aadhaar card and verifying the details of residence by asking orally.

Perused the Joint memo it is not oppose to public policy and is lawful.

Hence it can be accepted.

As such I proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

Petition is allowed in terms of the Joint Memo filed by the parties.

The Joint Memo shall form part and parcel of the award.

The **respondent No.2** is hereby directed to pay the agreed amount of **Rs.12,00,000/- (Rupees Twelve Lakhs Only)**.

Out of the deposit amount, **80%** of compensation amount shall be released in favour of Petitioner through E-payment on proper identification and the remaining

amount of **20%** shall be deposited in her name in any nationalized or scheduled bank of her choice for a period of **three years** and she is at liberty to withdraw the periodical interest.

Draw an award accordingly.
