Examination in chief by Advocate for R-2:

I have filed my Affidavit in lieu of my Chief-examination. The contents of the said Affidavit are true to the best of my knowledge and have affixed my signatures after going through its contents.

Cross examination by advocate for petitioner:-

It is true to suggest that as per documents, as on date of accident, the motorcycle was ridden by the petitioner. It is true to suggest that after thorough investigation, the police have filed charge sheet against Tempo. We have not challenged the charge sheet before any authority. It is false to suggest that I have deposed falsehood in para-3 of my chief affidavit. It is false to suggest that after thorough investigation and verifying the documents of Tempo, the police have filed a charge sheet.

2. It is true to suggest that the police have not filed a charge sheet alleging that the Tempo was not having permit at the time of accident. Witness voluntary states

that without conducting proper investigation, police have filed a false charge sheet. It is false to suggest that as on date of accident, the driver of Tempo was having valid DL and the Tempo was having valid permit. It is false to suggest that without conducting proper investigation, I have produced Ex.R2 to Ex.R-6 documents. It is false to suggest that in order to escape from our liability, I am deposing falsehood before this court by filing this false affidavit.
