

Case again called out at 5.00 pm.

Complainant absent.

No representation.

Perused the order sheet it reveals that in the year 2016 the present complaint is filed by the complainant.

Inspite of sufficient opportunities given to the complainant he was not taken any steps against the accused. Considering this, this court has dismissed the complaint for non prosecution.

Subsequently, complainant preferred appeal before the Hon'ble Appellate Court. The said appeal is allowed wherein Hon'ble Appellate Court directed the complainant to appear before the court without fail.

As per direction of Hon'ble Appellate Court restored the case on 22.07.2024. Thereafter complainant has not appeared before the court to proceed the case. But, learned counsel for the complainant appeared twice. Thereafter counsel also absent. Inspite of sufficient opportunities given to the complainant he did not appear before the court to proceed the case.

Hence, there is no reason to adjourn the matter for complainant evidence again and again.

Hence, case is dismissed for non prosecution.
