I have given treatment to the petitioner when she was inpatient in our hospital. I have done last operation to the petitioner. I have examined the petitioner in OPD on 29.04.2023 and also on earlier days. She has also visited other departments of our hospital for followup.

- 2) The petitioner has not approached me after April – 2023. I am not sure whether the petitioner has visited 2 or 3 times

after her discharge on third admission. I have come here to give evidence with regard to the treatment given by me and also to produce the inpatient records. If summons is issued, OPD records can be produced before the Court. OPD records will not be with the patient. It is false to suggest that in order to help the petitioner I have produced the documents by creating them.
