Cross examination by advocate for Respondent no.2:-

I have ration card. I can produce the same before this court. I was traveling as a pillion rider on the motorcycle at the time of accident. I was proceeding from Gubbi to Tumkuru. The alleged road was highway road. While we were traveling on the motorcycle, the offending car came from back side and collided with our vehicle. It is false to suggest that as per documents, at the time of accident, we were taking turn. It is false to suggest that rider of the motorcycle was caused the accident as a result, I sustained injuries.

2. I was immediately shifted to MC hospital, Tumkuru. I received first aid treatment, thereafter I shifted NIMHANS hospital. I was not admitted in the NIMHANS hospital. Again I went to MC hospital and I underwent inpatient treatment for a period of five days. The doctors of MC hospital have noted in their registers regarding accident. It is false to suggest that as per MC hospital documents, I fell on my own from the motorcycle.

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3. It is false to suggest that the accident did not occur due to negligence on the part of driver of the offending vehicle rather it occurred due to negligence on the part of rider of motorcycle. It is false to suggest that in order to fix the offending vehicle in this case, I have got created MC & NIMHANS hospital medical documents. I underwent surgery to my right leg. It is false to suggest that as per medical documents, I did not undergo any surgery. It is false to suggest that as per medical documents, at the time of discharge, I was in stable condition.

4. It is false to suggest that as per Ex.P-18 CT brain scan, I was normal at the time of discharge. It is false to suggest that I have not produced documents to substantiate that I have incurred Rs.50,000/-towards follow up treatment. My present age is 59. It is false to suggest that as per medical documents, my age was 74 years at the time of accident. I can produce the documents with respect to my avocation on next date of hearing.

5. I have a half acre agriculture land. It is false to suggest that I deposed falsehood in para-9 of my chief affidavit regarding avocation and income. It is false to suggest that I am hale and healthy and leading my life as I did prior to accident. It is false to suggest that in order to get

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compensation from this court, I have got created the documents and am deposing falsehood before this court by filing false affidavit. I can produce ration card to substantiate my age is 59 years.

Note: It is noticed by the court that the age of the petitioner appears more than 70 years and he is unable to stand in the witness box.
