

plaintiff and defendant are present.

Learned counsel for the plaintiff and defendant have jointly filed joint memo, stating that matter has been settled between the parties and prays to record the same.

Perused the joint memo.

It appears that the matter has been settled for a sum of Rs.50,000/-. The defendant has issued cheque bearing no.129418 dated 02.05.2026 drawn on Canara bank, Bengaluru, Peenya Industrial estate, drawn in favour of plaintiff. The said cheque has been handed over plaintiff.

On enquiry with the parties present before the court, they have admitted contents of joint memo. It appears that the parties have voluntarily entered into settlement. The proposed settlement is not against law or public policy. Therefore, I proceed to pass the following;

ORDER

The joint memo filed by the plaintiff and defendant is hereby allowed.

The suit of the plaintiff is hereby decreed in terms of joint memo.

The joint memo is part and parcel of the decree.

In view of settlement, office is directed to refund the court fee to the plaintiff through e-payment on due verification.
