Arguments heard. Order pronounced.

Vide my separate detailed judgment of the even date, accused namely Pardeep @ Chotu, Sumit and Deepak have been acquitted of the charges framed against them.

At this stage, learned counsel for the accused Sumit and Pardeep @ Chotu has submitted that their previous bonds be treated as bail bonds as required to be furnished under Section 437-A of Code of Criminal Procedure.

Application for restoration of previous surety bonds under Section 437-A Cr.P.C. also moved on behalf of applicants-accused Sumit and Pardeep @ Chotu. Heard. The present application stands disposed off.

Their bail bonds and surety bonds will remain intact for

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further six months in accordance with Section 437-A of Cr.P.C. in view of their application moved in this regard. Case property, if any, shall be disposed off as per rules.

Personal bonds on the tune of Rs.50,000/- in compliance of Section 437A of Cr.P.C. has been furnished on behalf of accused Deepak.

Jail authorities are directed through video-conferencing to release the accused Deepak from custody, if he is not required in any other case.
