Chief examination by the advocate for Petitioner:

My company has received the summons from this court to depose the evidence and for production of documents. As per direction of this court, my company has deputed me to depose evidence before this court and for production of documents. Accordingly I am producing pertaining to the deceased available in our company.

Cross examination by Sri.KP advocate for Respondent:-

It is true to suggest that as per our records, date of birth of the deceased is recorded as 20.07.1987. At the time of death, the deceased was working as a Administrative officer. Gross salary of the deceased was Rs.67,620/- and his net salary was Rs.41,450/-. we have not made any full and final settlement to the deceased's

family. Witness states that because the share ratio is 65% to the deceased wife and mother share ratio is 35%. Compensate ground is given to the deceased's wife Kavyashree. She is working as Assistant clerk. She may get around Rs.35,000/-salary per month.

2. It is true to suggest that the salary is remitted to employees' bank account. In our company there is no personal accident insurance policy.
