The petitioner by name Adhitya is present.

Learned advocate for the petitioner is present.

Learned advocate for **R2** / Insurance company is present.

The parties file joint memo / compromise petition.

I have carefully perused the terms and conditions of the joint memo.

I am satisfied that the terms and conditions of this joint memo are legal and valid, and by this compromise entire claim of the parties will be fully settled.

Thereafter, I have read over the terms and conditions of this compromise to the petitioner, in Kannada vernacular, and in turn, the petitioner accepted the terms and conditions of this compromise petition, and so also admitted the execution of this joint memo.

Thus, the joint memo is accepted.

Hence, I pass the following:

ORDER

The petition is allowed in terms of this compromise petition / joint memo.

Office is directed to draw award accordingly.

Respondent No.2 is directed to deposit the compensation amount within two months from today. **If R2** fails to deposit the compensation amount within the stipulated time, then, the compensation amount shall carry interest at the rate of 6% per annum.

Note: The petitioner is a MBBS Student and he has submitted that his father has spent considerable amount towards his medical treatment, hence, he prays for release of entire amount.

Considering the fact that the petitioner is a well qualified person and this court is of the opinion that he is capable of taking care of his money matters, the

office is directed to release the entire compensation amount to the bank account of the petitioner through E-payment after deposit of the same.
