Cross examination by Advocate for petitioner:-

I read the police documents. It is true to suggest that as per police documents, the deceased was traveling in the car bearing no.KA-50-MB-7888 as an inmate and not as a driver. It is true to suggest that as per police documents, the driver of our insured vehicle was driving his car at high speed and in a rash and negligent manner and collided to the divider and went to other side of the road and dashed against the car bearing no.KA-50-MB-7888, as a result, the accident occurred.

2. It is true to suggest that the charge sheet was filed against the driver of our insured vehicle. I have not produced any documents to substantiate that false charge sheet has been filed against our insured vehicle. It is true to suggest that I am not aware what quantum of alcohol was consumed by our insured car driver.
